II. General Rules

- **1.** One school can represent only one Sahodaya in the State Kalotsav. Only students from schools which are affiliated to CBSE and having membership in a sahodaya complex shall participate in the State Kalotsav. The list of participants for the Kalotsav is to be registered by the respective sahodayas.
- Any participant/team from a school can register for State Kalotsav only through one of the registered Sahodayas. Sahodayas can register by sending the following details to the given E-Mail ID: <u>cbsestatekalotsav2k24@gmail.com</u>
 - a) Name of the Sahodayas
 - b) List of office bearers
 - c) List of member school
- **3.** Schools can register for State Kalotsav only through one of the registered sahodayas.
- **4.** Website of the Kalotsav <u>https://keralastatecbsekalotsav.in/</u> will be accessible from **30 September 2024**
- Pass word for online registration can be obtained by the sahodaya heads by 21 October 2024 from the kalotsav office- 9894479536, 9633311002
- Last date of Online registration for State Kalotsav will be 28 October 2024 and last date for any corrections will be on 29 October 2024.
- **7.** One student shall participate in a maximum of five single items and 2 group items. Out of 5 Single items only 3 can be stage items. However a student can participate in 5 off stage items provided he or she is not participating in any stage items.
- **8.** A student from a lower category cannot compete in a higher category and vice versa.
- **9.** Identity Card issued by the organizing committee of the Kalotsav is compulsory for participating in any event.
- **10. (a)** Participation in the following common group items shall be irrespective of category or sex.

(1) Group Song	(2) Patriotic Song
(3) Mime	(4) English One Act Play
(5) Western Music Concert	(6) Band

(b) Participation in the following common group items shall be irrespective of category

- (1) Thiruvathirakkali (Girls) (2) Oppana (Girls)
- (3) Margham Kali (Girls) (4) Kolkkali (Boys)
- (5) Duffmutt (Boys)
- **11.** Even if there is only one entry for an item, the competition shall be conducted and grade, prize and points will be awarded
- **12.** The CBSE Kalotsav shall be held at three levels
 - a) School level
 - b) Sahodaya level
 - c) State level
- **13.** Each Sahodaya shall organize Kalotsav framing rules and regulations in accordance with the State Manual.
- **14.** Only one participant/ team from a school can participate in the Sahodaya level competition.
- **15.** First and second position winners in each item and in each category shall be selected in the Sahodaya level, to participate in the State Kalotsav with a restriction that only two participants / teams from a sahodaya is eligible to register in the state level competition. For the English One Act Play (common item) there shall be only one entry from each Sahodaya.
- **16.** The General Convener of the Sahodaya Kalotsav shall prepare the list of the winners of the first two places in each item. He/she shall ensure that only two entries are made for any event and only one team for English One Act Play. It shall be the responsibility of the sahodaya head to register the names of the eligible participants / teams with the State Kalotsav committee on time.
- **17.** If a participant comes for State Kalotsav, without proper registration on time, through a Sahodaya, the claim for participation will not be entertained on any ground.
- **18.** The mark sheets, tabulation sheets, result sheets etc. shall be kept in the safe custody of the General Convener of the Sahodaya Kalotsav and must be handed over to the convener of the core committee after the Kalotsav.

- **19.** All decisions pertaining to the conduct of the State Kalotsav shall be taken by the core committee.
- **20.** The following sub committees shall be constituted for the smooth and effective conduct of the Kalotsav.
- 1. Registration
- 2. Reception
- 3. Programme
- 4. Tabulation and Judges
- 5. Stage, Panthal, Light & Sound
- 6. Finance
- 7. Food & Accommodation
- 8. Law & Order
- 9. Prizes, Trophies & Certificates
- 10. Publicity, Press & Media
- 11. Judges
- 12. Discipline & Volunteers
- 13. Transport
- 14. Welfare
- 15. Appeal
- 16. Stage Management

21. Each committee shall have Chair Persons and Vice Chair Persons from the Confederation of Kerala Sahodaya Complexes. There shall be conveners from the local area and sufficient number of members for the smooth coordination of the activities. For the Judges Committee alone there shall be only two Chairpersons, one from the organizing association along with a local convener from the host school.

22. Appeal Committee

The Appeal committee shall consist of the following members. The quorum for meeting shall be a minimum of 4 members.

- 1. Convener of the Core committee (Chairman of the appeal committee)
- 2. President and General Secretary of the Confederation of Kerala Sahodaya Complexes
- 3. Programme Co-ordinator
- 4. Expert of the concerned item

23. Finance

The funds for the State Kalotsav shall be raised through four sources.

a) Contribution from Sahodaya Complexes

Each Sahodaya shall pay an amount of **Rs. 35000**/- for participating in the State Kalotsav.

b) Individual participation fee of Rs. 500 per participant irrespective of the number of events.

c) Sale of food coupons

Participants and escorting teachers shall purchase food coupons at the venue, as per the rates fixed by the organizing committee.

d) Sponsorship

24. Court Appeals

Participant / team failing to get the nomination in the two entries from a Sahodaya and come for the state level competition with order from court of law will be allowed to participate in their respective event and grades / prizes / awards shall be given to the participant / team. The points for grade and prize (if any) will not be added to the school and to the Sahodaya in deciding the toppers of the Kalotsav.

- **25.** Group items can be registered with two standbys to substitute the performers in case of emergency. However, substitution while performing on the stage will not be allowed. Certificates and prizes will be given only to those students who perform on the stage. Students, registered as standby, need not pay any registration fee. They will not be issued any Participation Certificate.
- **26.** The qualifications and credentials of the judges shall be announced on the stage before the commencement of each item.
- **27.** Once the competition is over, the stage managers shall do the tabulation work in the presence of the judges. When the tabulation is completed, the code number and the grade of the winners shall be announced on the stage by one of the judges.
- **28.** In case the prize winners are not participating in the Stale Kalotsav, Sahodaya can promote the next position holder to participate, provided all disputes arising out of such promotion is to be settled by Sahodaya heads at their level. State Committee will approve only the list forwarded by each Sahodaya heads.
- **29.** Procedures to be followed in participating in an Event.
- Participant / Team Manager shall report at the respective stage at least half an hour before the commencement of the competition along with the ID card of the participant/s. Those who fail to report at the venue on time may be disqualified without further enquiry.
 If the number of participants is above 20, clusters shall be formed

by the organizing committee in advance. If there are clusters for the competition, get the time of reporting for that event from the stage manager.

- ii. In case of no clusters or if a participant reaches the venue at the allotted time, the participant should surrender the ID card, get the order number through a lot and the chest number and wait for their chance to perform.
- iii. Perform on the stage as and when your chest number is called out.
- iv. Participants should return the chest number to the concerned Stage Manager after the performance and should collect their ID cards before leaving the venue.

- 2. Participation certificates shall be given to all participants other than the winners of the first, second and third places

TROPHIES TO SCHOOLS

- i. Schools securing first, second and third position in total points shall be awarded with Ever Rolling Trophies.
- ii. Schools securing first, second and third position in each category shall be awarded with trophies.
- iii. School securing first position in each district shall be awarded with trophy.
- iv. (In identifying and declaring the winners in all the above three the grades and positions of the participants / teams in the prize winning items only shall be considered.)
- v. The school that comes first in the aggregate points considering the grades and positions of the participants/teams in all items shall be awarded with an ever rolling trophy but not as the winner school.

TROPHIES TO SAHODAYA / DISTRICT

- i. Sahodayas / Districts securing first, second positions in every category shall be awarded Ever Rolling Trophies.
- ii. Sahodayas / Districts securing first, second positions in total points, shall be awarded overall Ever Rolling Trophies.
- iii. In ranking the sahodayas, the grades and the positions of the participants shall be considered.

III. APPEAL

- i. Appeals on genuine grounds shall be entertained, if submitted by the participant within one hour of the announcement of result to the Chairman of the appeal committee. The appeal shall be submitted along with an **appeal fee** of **Rs. 2000/-.** Appeal shall be filled only by the Principal of the concerned school or the Team manager. In the case of State Kalotsav the appeal shall be duly counter signed by the concerned Sahodaya head/ official delegate.
- To be eligible to sign on the appeal, a delegate of the sahodaya head has to submit the duly attested letter from the sahodaya head in the Kalotsav office.

- iii. The appeal committee shall have the right to accept or reject an appeal after scrutiny. The decision of the appeal committee shall be final and binding.
- iv. The appeal fee (i.e. Rs. 2000) shall be forfeited, if the complaint is rejected by the appeal committee.

IV. FOOD AND ACCOMODATION

Food and refreshments shall be arranged at the venue for the participants, escorts and the officials. Food coupons at the rate fixed by the food committee shall be purchased by the team in advance.

Guidance can be given to the participants for availing accommodation.

III. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS REGARDING THE COMPETITIONS

- 1. In the manual where an item shown as common for boys and girls, means that there will be no separate competition for boys and girls. A Group item shown as common for boys /girls/ category, means that boys alone or girls alone or both boys and girls together irrespective of category shall perform the item.
- 2. For the items where back stage singing is allowed, singers shall belong to the same category and sex. In case of common items, singers shall be boys/girls/mixed.
- 3. In all competitions both stage performers and back stage performers are eligible for certificates and prizes. In the case of One Act Play, characters and 3 persons for stage arrangements will be given certificate.
- 4. In the case of Thiruvathira, Margham Kali and Oppana, both stage performers and back stage performers shall wear the same costume and make up.
- 5. For Ottanthullal, back stage singers can be non-students as well.
- 6. For writing and drawing competitions, participants shall bring pen, pencil, colour etc. Only paper shall be provided at the venue. The subject/ topic shall be decided by the judges.
- 7. For elocution, topics shall be given in advance. But for extempore, topic shall be decided by the judges and given to the participants five minutes before the competition.

- 8. For classical music competition, sruthi box shall be allowed and participants can sing any raga.
- 9. In Mappilapattu, film songs shall not be allowed.

- d) Sound effects, including additional music effects, that are appropriate for the scene are allowed, but all dialogue must be performed live (no pre-recorded dialogue is permitted). The use of a keyboard or recorded background music is allowed.
- e) No light effects allowed for the play
- f) Number of characters in the play should not exceed 10 persons. 3 persons are allowed for stage preparation, which must be completed within a maximum of 5 minutes.
- g) Prior settings on the stage will not be permitted.
- h) Any movable props that can be arranged within the allotted stage setup time may be used, but they must be kept inside the curtain. The area outside the curtain cannot be utilized for this purpose. Only the participants are allowed to handle the stage setup; trainers or any other non-participants are not permitted on stage before or after the performance.
- i) The curtain will rise at the beginning of the play and will only fall after the play has concluded.
- j) The Best Character Award will be given regardless of gender. No points will be awarded to the school or Sahodaya for this award.

- e) The members of the orchestra can also provide vocal support.

- h) Keyboard should be played live. No earlier sequencing, feeding allowed.
- i) Use of floppy disk, pen drive and memory card not allowed.
- j) A total of 6 microphones and 4 instrument ports will be provided.
- k) Common group item- No category and no male female separation.
- Key Board and drum set will be provided by the organizers on the stage, which will be common for all and no keyboard from outside will be allowed.
- m)Keyboard (Yamaha PSRi 500) and Drum Set (Chancellor Spice Drum) will be provided by the organizers which are common for all. No other instruments which are similar in nature will be allowed (Organ, Piano, Rhythm pad, Composer etc).
- n) Guitar can be of any type (Electrical or Ordinary). Synthesizer and Distortion can be used to give more effect, which shall be brought by the participants. If the team wants to use an additional instrument they may use any of the following **1.Violin (western) 2. Flute. 3. Triple or Congo drum**. No other instruments are allowed.
- o) Organizers will arrange a technical person for general setting of instruments. Other settings and tuning if any shall be done by the participants only. Trainers or any other technicians other than participants will not be allowed on the stage before and after the performance.

IX. PROGRAMME CO-ORDINATION RULES

- 1. Core committee shall be the only official body to decide up on all matters regarding the State Kalotsav.
- 2. Before going to the judgment seat, every judge shall deposit his/her cell phone with the judges-in-charge and get a slip against it.
- 3. The Core committee shall fix the Venue for the State Kalotsav after making a physical inspection of the infrastructure availability at the venue-school.
- 4. The venue school shall abide the rules and regulations given in the manual of CBSE State Kalotsav.
- 5. The venue school shall collect the **participants' fee of Rs.500** from a participant and *the contribution of Rs.35,000/- from a Sahodaya* and make the sale of food coupons. The state level organisers and the finance committee shall raise necessary funds through sponsors.
- 6. Banners, posters, arches and other hoardings for the publicity of the State Kalotsav shall bear the name of the Kalotsav, venue and date.
- 7. There shall be a room for the core committee members and for the state level office bearers.
- 8. Food for the Committee members and the judges shall be arranged by the host school.

INFORMATION TO THE JUDGES

- 1. A separate room is arranged for the judges when they are not involved in the judgement.
- 2. In no case there shall be any public contact. Even talking to the people in the premises is to be avoided.
- 3. Judgment of an item in a particular category will take place at a stretch inclusive of all clusters.
- 4. There is no separate lunch break. As and when one particular category.
- 5. If the competition is over, the judges shall be escorted to the mess hall for the lunch by the judges-in-charge. If the item prolongs, tiffin will be served at the Judgment seat which they consume when a particular cluster in a category gets over.
- 6. After the judgment the tabulation work will be done by the tabulators in the presence of the judges and one of the judges will announce the result on the stage.
- 7. There will be three lights on the stage Red, Green and Yellow. Green indicates the starting of the item. Yellow indicates there is only one minute left. Red indicates the time limit is over. If a participant exceeds the time limit, the person is not eligible for any prize. In the stage where light indicator is not provided, bell system will be allowed.
- 8. In case a technical fault occurs before half the time of an item, that event will be restarted; but if it happens after the half time, that item can performed again at the end of that particular cluster.
- 9. Before starting the judgement, the stage manager will announce the profile of the judges in each stage. So, the profiles of the judges are to be given early enough to make necessary arrangements.
